RESOLUTION NO. 2024-41

A Resolution authorizing and directing the Safety-Service Director to prepare and submit an application for a United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development Grant for the construction of the new Police Department building at 71 Sychar Road, Mount Vernon, Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-45

A Resolution authorizing and directing the Safety-Service Director to prepare and submit an application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant; and declaring an emergency.

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-46

A Resolution authorizing the Safety-Service Director to dispose of vehicles in the Police Department not needed for public use by the City of Mount Vernon; and declaring an emergency.
