




Captain Hunter's Landing Splash Pad Rules

SEASONAL HOURS:

**10am-8pm, Sunday-Saturday
During the Summer months**

Patrons can use the activator sensors to start the splash pad. They are located on the splash pad area.



- To report any issues please call 740-393-9501 during normal business hours.
- There is no facility supervision. Parent/Guardian is responsible for themselves and their children. Failure to follow rules may cause loss of use of the facility.
- All participants must conduct themselves in a courteous and safe manner.
- No climbing on splash pad features.
- No food, no drinks, no glass
- No tobacco/vaping products, no alcohol
- No littering
- No spitting, no urinating, no defecating
- No nose-blowing, no spouting of water
- No soap or bathing
- Persons having cuts, contagious or communicable diseases, open sores, wounds, fever, exposed bodily fluids, shall not be allowed to enter the sprayground
- Do not use the splash pad if you are experiencing diarrhea
- Do not drink the splash pad water
- Do not use during severe weather conditions, i.e., thunderstorms, tornados, etc.
- No skateboards, rollerblades, bikes, motorized vehicles or scooters
- No animals/pets
- No running or rough play
- Swim diapers are required for non-toilet trained children. A bathing suit is required over a swim diaper.
- Please wash hands after using restroom and/or changing diapers
- Change diapers only in restrooms
- Swimsuits or appropriate attire must be worn at all times
- Water shoes/pool shoes only, no street shoes
