



HIAWATHA WATER PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

General Safety

- Running is not permitted at any time.
- Horseplay, sitting on shoulders, wrestling, dunking, or pushing anyone into the pool is prohibited.
- Only soft sponge balls are permitted in the pool.
- Water balls must be controlled and not thrown more than 10 feet.
- Face masks, snorkels, and fins are prohibited.
- Jumping over, upon, or near a swimmer in the water is prohibited.
- Hanging, climbing, or jumping over fences is prohibited.
- Pool patrons are not permitted to visit with lifeguards and/or pool attendants while on duty.
- All persons under the age of 18 must take a ten (10) minute rest period every hour.

Baby Pool Rules

- Only children under 5 are permitted in the baby pool.
- A responsible party must supervise every child at all times.
- All children not potty trained must wear swim diapers as well as a swimsuit at all times.

Water Slide Safety Rules

- User must slide on their back, feet first, with arms and legs crossed in the blue slide.
- Users must use an inner tube to ride the yellow slide.
- Hands and feet must be kept inside at all times.
- Patrons must be 48 inches tall to use the slides.
- Instruction of the slide attendant must be followed.
- No running, standing, kneeling, rotating, stopping, or tumbling on the slide.
- No diving from the slide.
- Move away from the slide and exit promptly.
- Loitering on steps is prohibited.
- Glasses may not be worn on the slides.
- Only adults are permitted on slides during break times, as staff allows.
- No life jackets on the slides.
- Remove jewelry that may cause injury.
- Prosthetic limbs are not prohibited on slides.
- Bathing suits with rivets, exposed zippers, buckles, or metal ornamentation are prohibited.

- Patron with serious medical conditions (such as back, heart, or seizure problems, etc.) are prohibited from using the slide.
- Shirts are prohibited while on the slides.

Dividing Pool Safety Rules

- No gainers, inwards, or twists permitted.
- Only one person on the diving board(s) at a time.
- Divers are only to bounce once when using the boards.
- Swimming under the diving boards is prohibited.
- Attempt all dives from the front end of the board.
- Non-swimmers and poor swimmers are prohibited from using the diving pool.
- Shirts are prohibited while on the diving board.

Play Structure Safety Rules

- Patrons must be 12 or under to be on the play structure.
- Users must wait until the landing area is clear before entering the slide.
- Horseplay will not be tolerated.
- No stopping on the inside of the slides.
- No climbing up or on the slides.
- Users must ride feet first down the slide.
- Move away from the slide and exit promptly.

General Rules for Hiawatha Water Park/Pool

- Coolers are subject to inspection by pool management.
- Alcohol and glass containers may not be brought onto the property.
- Improper conduct, profane language, and public displays of affection are forbidden.
- Persons under the influence of drugs and alcohol will not be admitted.
- No smoking.
- No person who is observed passing feces, urine, or blood into a pool shall be permitted to use the pool. Any person who has been refused entry to or removed from the pool under this paragraph because of an infectious wound may be granted entry upon presentation of a written statement from a physician that the condition is not infectious.
- Coast guard approved flotation devices are permitted, however an adult must be within arm's reach.
- All children not potty trained must wear swim diapers.
- Swimming suit must be worn at all times while in the pool.
- Children 12 and younger must be with responsible person 15 years of age or older to enter the pool.
- All food stays in designated eating areas.
- Paging is limited to emergencies or upon a request made by an adult caregiver at the front gate. The caregiver requesting a member being paged is required to wait at the front gate and may not enter behind the gate area without paying the daily walk-in rate.
- All Rules and Regulations are subject to change.
