RESOLUTION NO. 2025-69

A Resolution authorizing the Safety-Service Director to advertise for bids and to enter into a qualifications-based construction manager-at-risk contract for the new Police Station at 71 Sychar Road, Mount Vernon, Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-70

A Resolution declaring the official intent and reasonable expectation of the City of Mount Vernon, Ohio on behalf of the State of Ohio (the borrower) to reimburse its urban improvement fund for the Fairgrounds Road utilities improvements and resurfacing project (OPWC Project Number C-Q32AB) with the proceeds of tax-exempt debt of the State of Ohio; and declaring an emergency.
